## About iSPACE Camperships

Camp is a wonderful and enriching experience for kids. It is a place to learn new skills, meet new friends, and have fun! We want as many kids as possible to have the opportunity to attend our camps. However, we know that the cost of camp can be a burden for some families.

All iSPACE Camps are held on the grounds of Great Oaks/Scarlet Oaks campus in Sharonville, OH. Camps run Monday through Friday - 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

The iSPACE Campership Fund exists to help students attend an iSPACE camp. Campership awards are based on financial need and demand for camp is high; therefore, qualifying for a scholarship does not guarantee a campership award, or a spot in summer camp. This program allows one campership per child per summer. However, if a family has more than one child, applications can be submitted for each child.

## To Apply

Each applicant must supply:

1. 2019 Campership Application Form (attached)
2. One Letter of Recommendation from someone not related to you (Examples: Teachers, principals, community leaders, etc.)
3. Explanation of Financial Need (can be a letter from your teacher or principal stating you are eligible for free or reduced lunch at your school or other government documentation)
4. Patch Design (see explanation on next page)
5. Patch Explanation
6. Thank You Note due 1 week after camp – failure to complete will affect eligibility for 2020.

### Application Notes:

- Incomplete applications will not be considered
- All materials submitted will be held strictly confidential unless otherwise noted (see permission statement below)
- Full camperships cover tuition to one iSPACE camp program
- Partial camperships range in coverage depending on sponsor/applicant
- Expenses for Food and Transportation not included
- Camp choices are filled on a first-come, first-served basis and are subject to availability
- Previous campership winners are welcome to apply; however, new applicants will be considered first
- If you receive a campership, you must register online for available camps with award code

### Patch Design

NASA robotic engineering and space/aviation crews are teams where each member brings his/her strengths, talents, abilities, interests and achievements to the program. It has been a tradition in the space/aviation program for each crew to design a mission patch which represents the crew members individually, as well as collectively; in a way that also portrays the mission objectives.

As a part of this application process, we would like for you to design your own personal patch (must fit on 8-1/2" x 11" paper). We've included a template for you to use, but it is not necessary. Your patch should include things about you such as:

- Talents
- School and community activities
- Awards/honors
- Any events in your life that have had an impact on you
- Other activities/hobbies

The artistic design of the patch will **not** be a determining factor in campership selection, but, rather, the way the applicant is able to introduce himself/herself to us.

### Patch Explanation

Please attach a description of the patch (no longer than one page) that includes explanations of symbols, colors, lettering, etc. Applicants may use computer technology to aid in patch design, but the medium chosen for the design will not be a determining factor in the campership selection.

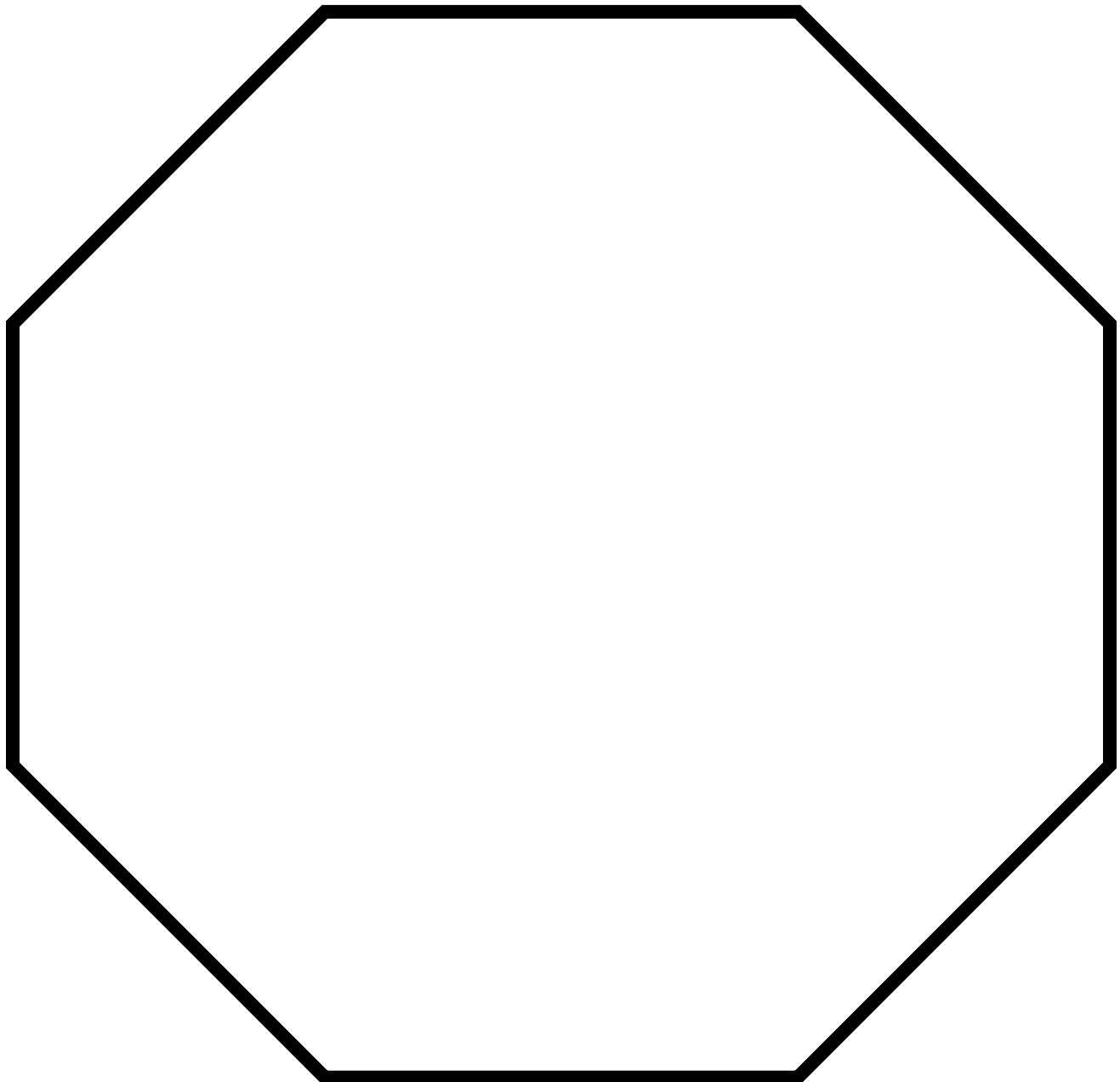
