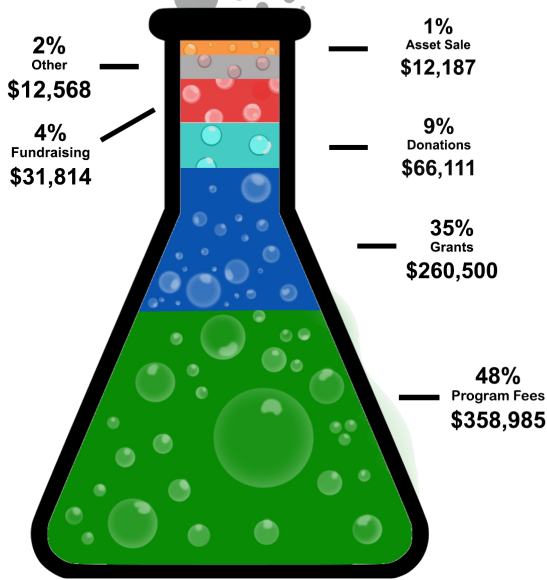
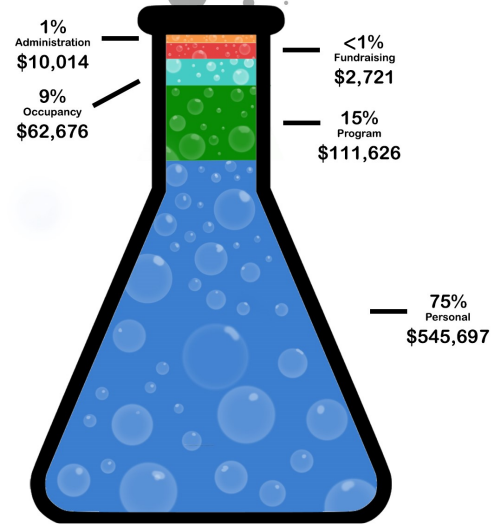

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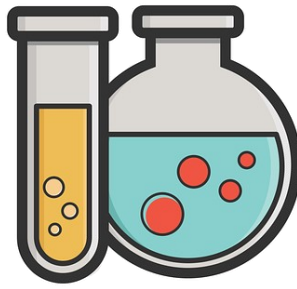

2018-19 has been another growth year for iSPACE!! We provided almost 450 programs to schools (a 7% increase from 2017-2018 school year). To inspire more underserved populations, we

- expanded our subsidized programs to more schools and served a total of 154 low income classes
- expanded our Girls in STEM program offerings to include two Girls Who Code clubs and an additional school year program

To continue challenging our students, we developed 7 new summer camps, many with an increased focus on the A (Art) component of STEAM. These camps were well received and created excitement and interest with more girls than past camps. Look for some exciting new school program offerings in the 2019-20 school year!
